## Solving Square/Cube Roots and Graphing Cube Roots

Solve each equation. Remember to check for extraneous solutions.

$$1) (\sqrt{21 - 4k})^2 = k^2$$

$$21 - 4k = k^2$$

$$-21 + 4k = k^2 - 21$$

$$0 = k^2 + 4k - 21$$

$$0 = (k+7)(k-3)$$

$$\cancel{-7} \quad +3$$

$$3) n = \sqrt[3]{125}$$

$$n = 5$$

$$5) p^2 = (\sqrt{6-p})^2$$

$$p^2 = 6-p$$

$$+p \quad -6+p$$

$$-6$$

$$p^2 + p - 6 = 0$$

$$(p+3)(p-2)$$

$$p = \cancel{-3} \quad 2$$

$$7) (3p-11)^2 = (p-3)^2$$

$$3p-11 = p^2 - 6p + 9$$

$$-3p + 11 \quad -3p + 11$$

$$0 = p^2 - 9p + 20$$

$$0 = (p-4)(p-5)$$

$$p = 4, 5$$

$$2) (2-n)^{\frac{1}{2}} = n^2$$

$$2-n = n^2 + n - 2$$

$$0 = n^2 + n - 2$$

$$0 = (n+2)(n-1)$$

$$n = \cancel{-2} \quad 1$$

$$4) (\sqrt{4b-24})^2 = (b-6)^2$$

$$4b-24 = b^2 - 12b + 36$$

$$-4b + 24 \quad -4b + 24$$

$$0 = b^2 - 16b + 60$$

$$0 = (b-6)(b-10)$$

$$b = 6, 10$$

$$6) (x+1)^3 = (3x+1)^3$$

$$(x^2 + 2x + 1)(x+1)$$

$$x^3 + 2x^2 + x + x^2 + 2x + 1$$

$$x^3 + 3x^2 + 3x + 1 = 3x^3 + 3x^2 - 3x - 1$$

$$x^3 + 3x^2 = 0$$

$$x^2(x+3) = 0$$

$$x = \cancel{-3}, 0$$

$$8) k-1 = (-3k^2 + 3k)^{\frac{1}{3}}$$

$$(k^2 - 2k + 1)(k-1)$$

$$k^3 - 2k^2 + k - k^2 + 2k - 1$$

$$k^3 - 3k^2 + 3k - 1 = -3k^3 + 3k^2 + 3k^2 - 3k$$


$$k^3 - 1 = 0$$

$$k^3 = 1$$

$$k = 1$$


Use a table to sketch the graph of the first function. After that use what you know about translations of functions to graph the other 3. State the point of inflection and then sketch the graph.

9)  $y = \sqrt[3]{x}$




Shifts: N/A

10)  $y = \sqrt[3]{x + 3} - 3$




Shifts: Left 3
